## Building Security into DevSecOps

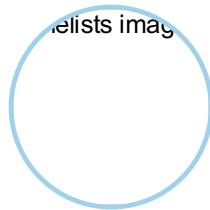
Many organizations struggle with how and where to introduce automation and integrations efficiently. Conventional approaches to application security can't keep pace with cloud-native environments that use agile methodologies and API-driven architectures, microservices, containers, and serverless functions. Application security testing is evolving to meet the speed at which DevOps teams operate.
